Bayswater Exploration & Production LLC. hosted a neighborhood open house Tuesday, January 27, 2015, from 6:00 pm to 8:00 pm in Greeley, Colorado at the Barnstormer Restaurant, 600 Airport Road. The event's goal was to meet neighbors, introduce them to Bayswater and learn about any homeowner and resident concerns surrounding the proposed oil and gas project in the East Greeley neighborhood.

Eight representatives from Bayswater, Troy Swain- the Weld County Oil and Gas Specialist and future LGD, Carlos Rodriguez- CRED, 3 Local Energy Office representatives, and 21 neighborhood residents were all present for a majority of the two-hour event. Bayswater fielded questions about all aspects regarding the proposed project, including the topics of noise abatement, access, truck traffic, project duration, number of planned wells, drilling practice, and well construction and completions. Safety, flood plains and land/ mineral interests were also discussed with several residents.

Bayswater prepared maps, exhibits, and project information sheets available for all. The documents were available in both English and Spanish and we had some of our Spanish-speaking service company representatives attend to facilitate good communication as needed. In addition, Bayswater distributed a project information phone number which will provide a 24 hour contact direct to Bayswater for the neighborhood (See Attached Project information sheet). In addition, we mailed a thank you letter to the residents.

The evening was an informative success. We received several comments from attendees with words echoing "nice job," "we look forward to your project now," and "Bayswater is well prepared."
