Mr. Waggoner:

On June 2, 2015, Talon/LPE conducted confirmation soil sampling at the Razor 33CPB Well Pad in Weld County, Colorado. The purpose of the sampling event was to ensure that all hydrocarbon impacted soil had been removed to the extent required by the Colorado Oil and Gas Conservation Commission (COGCC). A total of one (1) grab sample (SP-2 0-6") was collected and a site map with the sample location is presented in Figure 1.

The collected sample was analyzed for Total Petroleum Hydrocarbons (TPH) via Gasoline Range Organics (GRO) and Diesel Range Organics (DRO) method SW8015 and for Benzene, Toluene, Ethyl-benzene, and Xylenes (BTEX) via method SW8260 at ALS Laboratories in Fort Collins, Colorado. Sample SP-2 0-6" was reported to exhibit concentrations for all analytes below COGCC Table 910-1 concentration levels. A soil concentration map is presented in Figure 2 and a breakdown of the soil analytical data is presented in Table 1.

Based upon the collected analytical data, Talon/LPE believes that the hydrocarbon impacted soils have been removed and no further corrective action is necessary. If you have any questions or comments, please do not hesitate to call me at (979) 574-8371.
