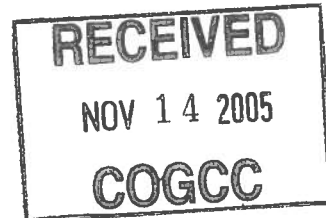

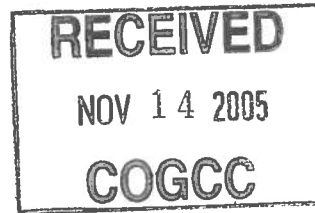
Dear Phil:

Our clients have been discussing for several months the best way to accommodate their correlative rights in the NW/4 of Section 23; the conversations have included meetings on the property between representatives of Kerr-McGee Rocky Mountain Corporation and Zeek Partnership, LLLP to arrive at mutually acceptable locations for the surface facilities of five wells, four of them to be drilled directionally.

The agreed-on locations are shown in the plat enclosed with this letter. KMRMC staff and JL Walter (Zeek's consulting engineers) have arrived at these by a careful negotiation, and they appear to respect the interests of all parties. The parties have engaged in good faith consultation concerning the location of roads, production facilities and wellsites, as required by COGCC Rule 306. In addition, the parties have negotiated and are close to executing a surface use agreement that sets forth their understanding as to the issues described in the preceding sentence.

Thank you for your help in negotiating this agreement; KMRMC will provide this letter to the COGCC, as confirmation that such consultation has taken place in accordance with

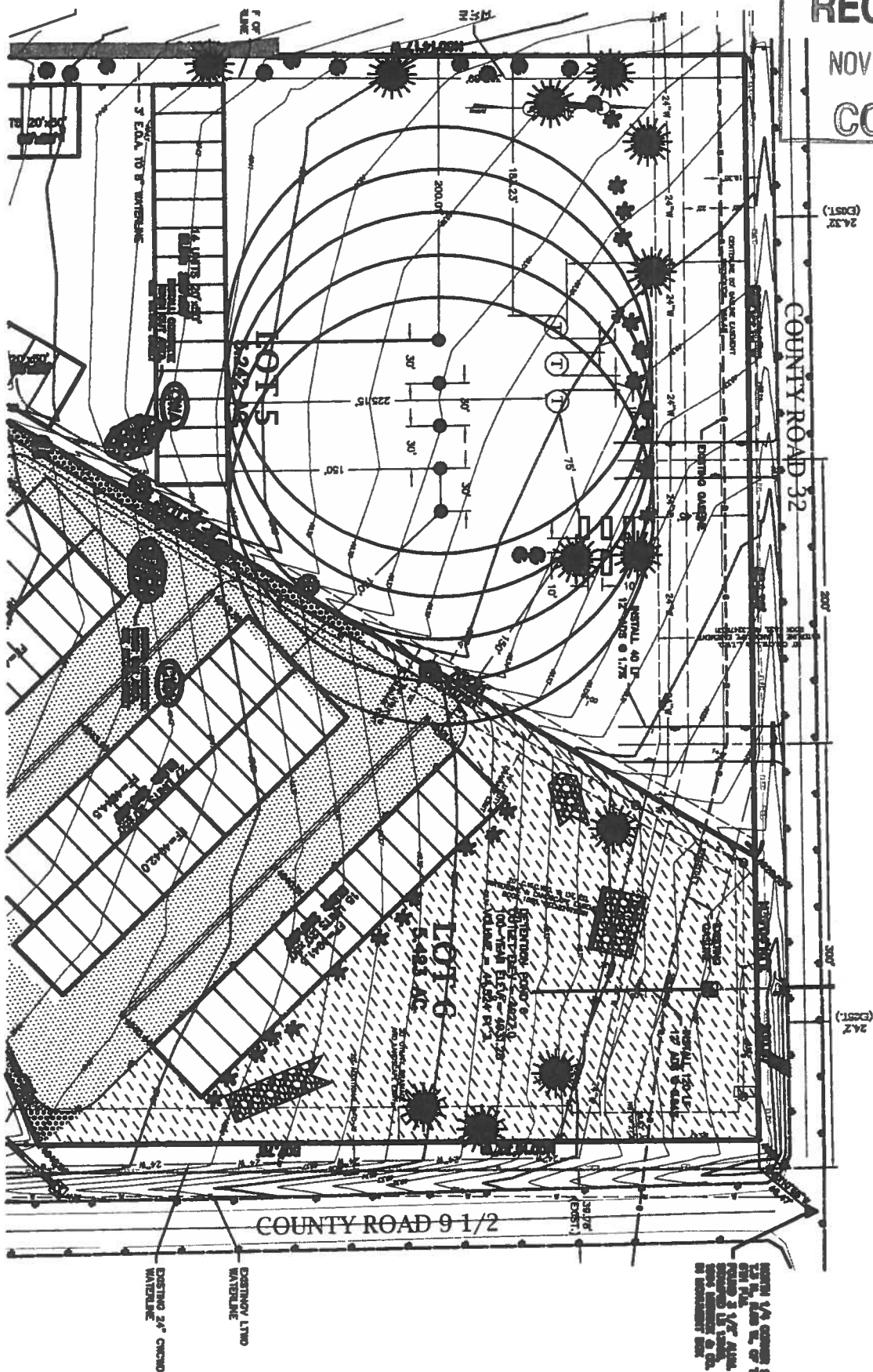

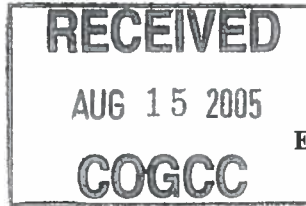

Dear Sir or Madam:

I represent Zeek Partnership, LLLP ("Zeek"). Enclosed please find a completed "Colorado Oil and Gas Conservation Commission (COGCC) Onsite Inspection Request Form" for the captioned property. This letter is written without waiver of any rights which Zeek may have with regard to the captioned wells, to object.

The initial Rule 306 consultation occurred on August 12, 2005. The parties discussed issues involving the number of wells to be drilled, the location of wells and support facilities, access to the wellsite, lease validity, visual or aesthetic impacts, surface impacts, noise impacts, safety impacts, and other matters. The operator agreed to conduct a site survey to determine whether a proposal by Zeek on where to locate the wells is satisfactory and feasible. This ought to be accomplished in the next 7 - 10 days. Thereafter, the parties will communicate further to see if they can resolve all issues relating to these wells.

Zeek will promptly report to you the results of those further discussions and advise the Commission whether any unresolved issues related to the five proposed wells remain. In the

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meantime, we ask that the Commission continue the period for Rule 306 consultation to allow the parties to use their best efforts to resolve their differences.
