Hi, Brandon,

I just left you a voicemail. The COGCC finds your attempts to obtain an open hole log more than sufficient and will not require that you make any further attempts on this pad.

I would like to request that a cased hole neutron log be run on one of the wells on this pad, preferably not the well you obtained the open hole log on.

This should not cost you additional rig time, only the cost of running the additional tool with the CBL.

Thank you for your valiant efforts in being compliant with the open hole logging requirements. Please let me know if you have further questions. It would be helpful if the Form 5's submitted for these wells specified the wells that have the open hole or cased hole neutron log, so if you can pass that on, I would appreciate it.

Thanks for taking the time to discuss our logging issue on the phone this morning. As I mentioned we have made multiple attempts to open hole log our SRC Cannon pad.

Here is a brief summary of the well, # of attempts and time spent trying to get logs down as deep as we can.

SRC Cannon S-16CHZ - API# 051234078100

Made 1 logging attempt. Time spent 1.75 hours

SRC Cannon 11-16CHZ - API# 051234078700

Wiper trip wellbore and made 1 logging attempt Time spent 30.25 hours

SRC Cannon 13-16CHZ - API# 051234078300

Wiper trip well bore and made 3 logging attempts with wiper trips between each attempt. Time spent 23.25 hours

SRC Cannon 13-16NHZ - API# 051234078400

Made special reamer run and made 3 logging attempts with wiper trips between each attempt. Time spent 51.5 hours

I attached the logs that we did get down on the SRC Cannon 13-16CHZ - API# 05123407830013 well. It made it down to 5,500'. We also have additional gamma on this well from 5800 to TID of Intermediate.

Is this information enough? We do have one more well we will drill. If you would like I will make one more attempt to get logs down but as you can see it have been a challenge. If additional information is needed, is there an alternative that I can provide.
