I spoke with Paul Schneider at Anadarko. He said they did not perform any additional cleanup in the open excavation. They provided some pictures that show the excavation is in the same condition as it was last week. They agreed to submit their split sample results that were collected when your consultant performed soil sampling.

Before you replace your flowline section we need to verify that the confirmation samples collected below the release point comply with Table 910-1 standards. Please submit the results of your sampling analysis as soon as you can.
