Hi Rebecca,

Apologies for not getting back to you on this sooner. Halle no longer works for PDC so please direct all permitting inquiries to me.

To answer your questions - We did not amend the existing location because the existing production facilities only have the capability of supporting the one active vertical well to the north of the proposed location (Spaur 10-2) at this time. It would be economically illogical to amend the existing location due to capacity and the surface owner prefers that we do not, as the existing facilities will be removed and the area permanently reclaimed once the Spaur 10-2 is plugged.

Please go ahead and change the surface water to 0'.

The high occupancy building unit is 2561' to the NE from the edge of the production facility. Please see a cultural items map attached.
