Mr. Moser,

We spoke in January about sampling a water well on your property in association with future oil and gas wells to be drilled by Noble Energy. We attempted to collect a sample in January, but while on location the available sampling location (spigot) at the time was inoperable causing us to have to delay sampling at that time and re-evaluate sampling protocol. The sampling location (spigot) we were instructed to use by your hand was inoperable at that time, which prevented us from sampling the water well. At that time, LTE was instructed by Noble to hold off on sampling this well until closer to the estimated drill dates for the oil and gas wells located in the area of your water well (location is identified below). As such, we are now seeking to re-arrange access to collect a water sample from your water well.
