David,

I have reviewed the referenced Form 2A Oil & Gas Location Assessment and have the following comments.

1) A review of your Well Plat also indicates a ground elevation of 3,683 feet. However, you have listed a ground elevation of 3,612 feet in the Location Identification section and a post construction elevation of 3,612 feet in the Construction section. Please confirm the current and post-construction ground elevation of this proposed oil and gas location.

2) In the Cultural Distance section you have indicated the nearest Building Unit is greater than a mile from both the proposed well and production facility. However, during my review it appears that the nearest Building, that is 3,612 feet from the well and 3,046 feet from the production facility, is a residence. This would make it also the nearest Building Unit. Therefore I would like to change these two distances to the nearest Building Unit to match the distances to the nearest Building.

3) In the Cultural Distance section you have indicated that the nearest Public Road and Property Line is 600 feet from the production facility. However, your Location Drawing shows the production facility being 90 feet from the center-line of Phillips County Road 30. I suspect County Road 30 is also a Property Line as well. Therefore I would like to change these two distances to 90 feet.

4) Because the proposed location is a sensitive area due to it being within the Northern High Plain Designated Groundwater Basin, I would like to add the following Condition of Approval to the Form 2A:

"Location is in a sensitive area; therefore, either a lined drilling pit or closed loop system is required."
