EE3, LLC (EE3) is submitting this Sundry Notice (SN) Form 4 to the Colorado Oil and Gas Conservation Commission (COGCC) requesting relief from the wildlife timing stipulations from March 1 to June 30 for the wellsite development operations attached to the Oil and Gas Location Assessment (OGLA).

The Hebron 01-18HR well will be drilled on an existing wellpad upon which there are already two other producing wells. The wellpad is located near two homes, another active wellpad and State Highway 14. The high volume of traffic on State Highway 14 creates considerable disruption. The Hebron 01-18HR wellpad is bounded by roads and surrounded by hay meadows in every direction. The nearest sage grouse lek is over 2 miles away.

Due to the distance of the proposed Hebron 01-18HR well from significant sage grouse habitat and the well's proximity to homes and noisy State Highway 14, we believe that drilling and completion operations would not adversely affect sage grouse during the timing stipulation period.
