COMMENTS:

BP is requesting approval to employ Viper Drilling to bore 19 small-diameter short laterals from the existing wellbore. Each lateral will be limited to 30 feet in length. The Smith A1 is a vertical well and is located 1100' from the nearest spacing unit boundary. As a result, the location of the Smith A1 ensures the short laterals will not exceed the 660' spacing unit setback.

Attached is the Viper Drill procedure, current/proposed wellbore diagrams and an aerial depicting laterals in relation to 660' setback.
