



Photo 1. View of the northern portion of the project area from the northwestern portion facing eastward. Vegetation is largely comprised of weedy tumble mustard (*Sisymbrium altissimum*), cheatgrass (*Bromus tectorum*), and widely spaced intermediate wheatgrass (*Thinopyron intermedium*).

Photo 5. View of eastern portion of the project area from the southeastern corner facing northward. Dense, tall, and dry kochia (*Kochia scoparia*) plants are growing along the edge of the pad and in the interim reclamation area. These need to be removed.
