The Form 4 – Sundry Notice for the subject facility was approved by the COGCC on July 19, 2012. Water-based bentonitic drilling fluids were first transported to the site on June 27, 2012 in accordance with Rule 907.d(3). Associated cuttings were not applied at the site until after the Form 4 was approved. The facility became inactive on or about March 12, 2015 and prior to the 3 year timeline.

LT Environmental collected post application sampling on August 28, 2015. Laboratory results indicated concentrations and/or levels of arsenic, Electrical Conductivity, and Sodium Adsorption Ratio that exceed the Table 910-1 standards. Additionally, one sample (SS07) exceeded the benzo(a) pyrene standard.

As a result, PDC has imported manure as a soil amendment and incorporated into the location. Additional sampling will be conducted at a future date to determine compliance with the Table 910-1 standards. Upon favorable results, PDC will submit an eForm 4 with supporting documentation requesting closure of the subject facility.
