Jim- It is my understanding that Kinder Morgan did not get surface owner approval when the the liner was left in place and the pit back filled and covered, nor where the COAs followed on the Form 15, Pit Permit. Therefore, if Kinder Morgan is not able to provide the appropriate closure documentation from 2007, the pit shall be closed to current standards with the contents of the pit must meeting current 910-1 and the liner removed.
