PUBLIC NOTICE OF PROPOSED UNDERGROUND INJECTION CONTROL PERMIT

PURPOSE OF PUBLIC NOTICE:

The purpose of this notice is to solicit public comment on the NGL Apollo 11 disposal well, a Class II injection permit submitted by NGL Water Solutions DJ, LLC. The NGL Apollo 11 disposal well has a planned drilling location 1,446 feet from north line and 699 feet from east line SENE Section 18, Township 6 North, Range 83 West, 6th P.M., Weld County, Colorado.

BACKGROUND

Class II injection wells are permitted and regulated in such a manner as to prevent the contamination of underground sources of drinking water and to ensure fluid emplacement and confinement within the permitted injection zones. Class II injection wells are permitted to inject waste generated from oil and gas exploratory and production operations. NGL Water Solutions DJ, LLC has proposed to inject these fluids into the (top down) Lyons, L. Satanka, Wolfcamp, Amazon, Council Grove, Admire, Virgil, Missouri, Des Moines, Fountain, Atoka, and Morrow, Formations in the NGL Apollo 11 well through an open hole completion at depths of approximately 8,528-10,023 feet.

Public comments are encouraged and will be accepted, in writing at the Commission for a period of thirty (30) days after publication of this notice. If any data, information, or arguments submitted during the public comment period appear to raise substantial questions concerning proposed injection well permit, the Director may request that the Commission hold a hearing on the matter.

Additional information on the operation of the proposed injection well may be obtained at the Commission office.
