Hi Rick,

This morning while making his routine daily stop at the Walton 17-25, our pumper discovered that the wellhead had developed a leak. Approximately 3 bbls of oil were discovered around the wellhead, of which, 2 1/2 bbls were vac' trucked and recovered. The impacted soil has been excavated, the leak has been identified and fixed with simple tightening of the bolts on the flange. Samples will be taken around the well head to ensure the area has been cleaned up to COGCC standards.

I will submit the Form 19 this afternoon – it is currently in Draft form as Doc #400951465.
