I admit I'm not familiar with the Wells Ranch CPF, but if it is owned and operated by Noble, wouldn't that make it a Centralized E&P Waste Management Facility that we regulate and permit via a Form 2A and Form 28. Please provide some additional info about this facility as to why this isn't the case. Thank you.
