COMMENTS:

Pursuant to Condition of Approval item #3 in Sundry Notice 400436227, ConocoPhillips Company is hereby submitting an update on the status of gathering pipeline economics in the area of State of Colorado 36-1H in Adams County.

This well was drilled as part of our appraisal program. It is located in Section 36 of T3S, R64W in Adams County and is currently combusting gas using an enclosed high rate combustor. The original Bronco Pipeline connection planned for this well was delayed due to landowner opposition to Bronco Pipeline Company constructing pipeline in this area, and the high cost to connect the well due to crossing the Union Pacific Railroad, running pipe parallel to I-70 for approximately 4.5 miles, boring under I-70, or bisecting 4 sections of land. The nearest operating pipeline to the well is about 1.5 miles away, however it lies on the opposite side of Interstate 70, and as previously stated, would require a HDD crossing of I-70. The Bronco Pipeline system crosses I-70 about 4.5 miles to the west of this well. This is a marginally producing well currently combusting approximately 19 mcf/day or 6,864 mcf/year based on recent production reporting and in the current economic environment a connection would be very cost-prohibitive and well operation would be unable to continue if required.

This well is in compliance with CDPHE regulations and volumes reported monthly to the COGCC.
