DESCRIPTION

Pumper arrived on location at approx 9:30AM Wellhead and tank battery are at 2 different locations. Drove to wellhead, casing PSI was at 260. He opened the casing valve slightly to bleed PSI through flowline. Stayed at wellhead watching casing gauge to insure it was not dropping too fast.

He then drove to the tank battery and noticed a fire at the combustor. He put the fire out with a fire extinguisher and immediately shut in all valves feeding the treater and combustor. Also went back to the well to shut in the wellhead.

The 1" turbine meter on the oil dump apparently could not dump the oil as fast as it was coming in. The treater overflowed into the gas line to the combustor.

The turbine meter has since been bypassed.
