COGCC has reviewed the State M36-3, M36-5, 6, 7, 8-36 Groundwater Report and No Further Action Request submitted by Noble Energy, Inc. on June 24, 2016. Based on the information presented, it appears that no further action is necessary at this time, and COGCC approves the closure request. However, should future conditions at the site indicate contaminant concentrations in soil exceeding COGCC standards or if ground water is found to be significantly impacted, then further investigation and/or remediation activities may be required at the site. The site remains an active location and must comply with Rule 1003. Interim Reclamation.

Remediation Project #8495 and Spill Tracking #400631216 / Spill/Release ID #437708 have been resolved in COGIS.
