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A27 Release Update 7-14-2016

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The following represents the status of the A27 Discharge Line Release as of July 14, 2016.

- 30 days since the condensate-impacted spring water was discovered. Spring continues to flow with evidence of oil
- Safety
 - Worker safety and exposure assessment of various tasks ongoing
- Production
 - Impacts to production remain negligible
- Impacted surface water treatment plan
 - Separator operating effectively and capturing 10 – 12 bbls/day.
 - Additional 400 bbl gun-barrel tank and 200 bbl recovery tank will be installed next week, to add residency time and capacity to the system.
 - Total oil collection to date ~ 278 bbls. Updated volume release to be included in COGCC sundry submittal
 - Aeration was introduced at the pond outlet for additional treatment.
 - Surface water samples were collected along the area again this week to assess impacts, treatment and movement.
- Construction
 - Pond head gate to be replaced/repared after pond skimming is no longer required
 - Road and facility pad upgrades are being made this week to accommodate additional tanks
 - Secondary containment for oil/water separator system is being constructed this week
- Ecological Assessment
 - 11 borings / temporary monitoring wells installed. Additional borings locations are being identified
 - Associated water and soil samples submitted for analysis; results are being compiled and reviewed.
 - Survey of water wells and other key locations has been completed and will be incorporated in the impact assessment and will be used in development of remediation strategies.
 - Form 27/Form 4 will be submitted to COGCC once a remediation plan is selected.
- Surface Land
 - Impact limited to two privately owned properties
 - Communication with Landowners is ongoing

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
