Hi All,

Alan and Jessica of Black Hills stopped by today and told me that the 35-2 soils were sampled and that they won't be self-reporting to COGCC as ordered, since the samples were done to COGCC standards and meet Table 910 standards. I notified Linda Spry O'Rourke at COGCC and asked her to discuss it with me. I let her know that I told Alan to get all soil sampling results to me. So I guess we'll figure out if there's anything else to follow up on when we're all fully informed and on the same page.

In the meantime, the rest of Order JESC01111 (to bring down the slopes of the steep loose soil piles, stabilize them and bring them into compliance with BLM and CDPHE stormwater standards) is still in effect. Compliance deadline is 7/12/2011. I strongly suggest seeding now while soil conditions are good for accepting seed, since BH wants to leave the pad and pit active over a fairly long term.
