Dear Mr. Lepore,

Extraction Oil & Gas, LLC (Extraction) hereby certifies that it has complied with Rule 306.e, which states that an Operator shall be available to meet with Building Unit Owners who received an OGLA notice or a buffer zone notice pursuant to Rule 305.c. and requested a meeting regarding the proposed oil and gas location. The operator sent notices pursuant to Rule 305.c, and received requests from Mr. Gary Leinweber, Mr. Alan Herman, and Mr. Alvin Herman for a consultation.

Matthew Samel, surface landman with Extraction, met with Mr. Leinweber on June 16, 2016 at his home. Mr. Leinweber was not opposed to the project, but had some general questions. The length and location of the proposed wellbores were discussed as were the BMPs that will be implemented, such as sound walls and use of temporary lines to transport water to location instead of trucking. Mr. Leinweber also expressed concerns regarding his dog who will likely bark due to the presence of heavy equipment and dust. Extraction's dust mitigation BMPs were discussed.

Matthew Samel spoke with Mr. Alan Herman on July 6, 2016. Mr. Herman expressed aggravation in that he was not being compensated by this project and that the sound walls would block his view of the north and east. It was explained that the sound walls are a common BMP to mitigate noise and light during drilling and completion activities.

Matthew Samel spoke with Mr. Alvin Herman on August 1, 2016. Mr. Herman wanted to know what the truck route is going to be and if Extraction is still working on getting an access off Business Highway 34. It was explained that at this time all traffic is still planned to use 24th Street and Cherry Avenue, but that Extraction is still working to obtain an access permit from CDOT to use Business Highway 34. Mr. Herman also inquired as to when drilling would begin. The anticipated spud timeline of the fourth quarter of 2016 or first quarter of 2017 was discussed.
