Thanks for the submittal and I will get it processed. Questions I have are:

- What repairs were made to MW-3 as it was damaged and could not be sampled in June 2016? We took a [geoprobe out to the site and MW03 has been replaced](#).
- Could the 2-butanone detection be from repairing MW-3? Any glues or solvents used? I asked Tasman. We [typically use hand screwed joints so I'm sure where it came from](#).
- Could the acetone detection and the 2-butanone be a laboratory contaminant? I checked with the lab and they did some QA/QC and they didn't think that was a possibility. The lab doesn't use any acetone. They did offer the link [as below as a possible explanation](#).
