Tyler,
I am returning the Sundry that you sent to draft for the following corrections:

- 1) The Rule 609 Sundry notice is only for requesting exceptions to the Rule and to request sample substitutions and may not be used to submit analytical data to the COGCC. The analytical data should be removed from the Sundry. Analytical data must be uploaded directly to the COENV database in the Electronic Data Deliverable (EDD) format.
- 2) Since you collected a sample then you should only be requesting 3 exceptions to the rule; currently you are requesting 4.
- 3) Either the number of unsuitable water sources or the number of suitable water sources that you could not access needs to be changed since a sample was collected.

Once the corrections have been made you may resubmit the Sundry. Additional help regarding completing the Rule 609 Sundry can found in the link that I sent previously.
