**General Comment:**

On 9/27/2016 COGCC Environmental staff inspected spill location 447857, spill number 401117166. Weather was sunny and 69 degrees; there was evidence field wide that the area had experienced rains recently. Using the information provided on spill reports, the inspector attempted to determine that location in the field. The supplemental report had a lat/long that identified a pipeline right of way, soil appears to have been worked recently, no hydrocarbon staining or polling. Operator should demonstrate compliance with COGCC table 910-1 and COA on document number 401117166. Reclamation of surface should comply with COGCC 1000 series reclamation rules.
