Much equipment remained on location and was being cleaned with hydrovac trucks. Representative of operator on site indicated cleanup of soils in well location would begin after cleanup of equipment and relocation of equipment.

This inspection consisted of a track around the eastern and northern perimeter of the release area of areas to the north of the access road off CR 41 and starting just north of the well location.

The access road area had been partially scraped of hydrocarbons as shown in attached photo looking east and west from point to N of Adamson location

An area to the west of the noise baffle on west side of location was being scraped with impacted soils being removed from site under manifest for disposal.
