DURING THE EFR AND AIR SPARGING TIME PERIOD, THE MONITORING WELLS WILL BE SAMPLED QUARTERLY TO ASSESS REDUCTION IN DISSOLVED PHASE PETROLEUM HYDROCARBON CONCENTRATIONS USING USEPA METHOD 8260B (BTEX AND NAPHTHALENE).
