

## PURPOSE OF PUBLIC NOTICE:

The purpose of this notice is to solicit public comment on the EWS #4 injection permit submitted by Expedition Water Services Colorado LLC. The EWS #4 is a new vertical well being drilled expressly for commercial EPA-Class II disposal. The proposed surface drilling location is 2157 feet from the south line and 488 feet from the east line in the NE/4 of the SE/4 of Section 18, Township 2 North, Range 63 West, 6th P.M., Weld County, Colorado. Note that the EWS #4 will be paired with a second vertically drilled well, the EWS #4A, located 2700 feet to the northeast with a similar injection zone.

## BACKGROUND

Class II injection wells are permitted and regulated in such a manner as to prevent the contamination of underground sources of drinking water and to ensure fluid emplacement and confinement within the permitted injection zones. Class II injection wells are permitted to inject waste generated from oil and gas exploration and production operations. Expedition Water Services Colorado LLC proposes to inject these fluids into the Lyons (8,750-8,972 ft), Lower Satanka (8,972-9,217 ft), Wolfcamp (9,217-9,278 ft), Amazon (9,278-9,335 ft), Council Grove (9,335-9,511 ft), Admire (9,511-9,583 ft), Virgil (9,583-9,809 ft), Missouri (9,809-9,948 ft), and Fountain (9,948-10,119 ft) Formations in the EWS #4 through an open-hole completion using a slotted liner. (Note: The EWS #4A and EWS #4 formation tops are the same because at this time they are estimates, the wells have not been drilled.)

Public comments are encouraged and will be accepted, in writing at the Commission for a period of thirty (30) days after publication of this notice. If any data, information, or arguments submitted during the public comment period appear to raise substantial questions concerning proposed injection well permit, the Director may request that the Commission hold a hearing on the matter.

Additional information on the operation of the proposed injection well may be obtained at the Commission office.



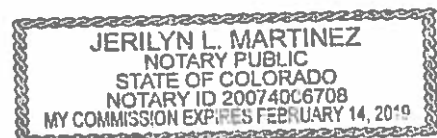
