Crestone Peak Spoke to Jason Oates, and emailed Bridget (don't recall her last name, PR person). Jason agreed to meet with me but is not available until the first week of June. He emailed me the following information: "Based on the basis of your email, the most credible information I can share related to the air quality at the Waste Connection site are the results of the CDPHE's testing at the Woolley Becky-Sosa site in February. Crestone is using the same drilling fluids at the Waste Connection, thus it is an accurate and logical comparison. Of note is the conclusion that, "All samples were approximately the same or below average air concentrations over the same month from a background site in an oil and gas region along the Front Range." Therefore, any degradation in air quality near the Waste Connection well pad is not attributable to Crestone's activity." While this is good information it does nothing to alleviate my concern of an odor nuisance. I cannot have enjoyment of my backyard due to the transient nature of these odors.
