Thank you for your time today. Per our discussion, PDC is requesting an extension to the COA deadline of August 13, 2017, issued for the **Wacker 1** location (Rem# 10179). Initiation of remediation activities is not feasible by August, as the former battery is now located in active cropland. Per landowner request, remediation activities will be conducted after the fall harvest. PDC agrees to the COGCC revised deadline of November 2017.
