Comment: The access road has not been reclaimed. Revegetation is establishing in portions of the location but there are areas where there was little to no establishment. Since the previous inspection additional seeding was performed in areas at the location and along the access road however there are areas that do not appear to have been seeded. There is a patch noxious weeds (Canada thistle) found at approximate Lat/Long:38.86573,-104.49155. See Attached Photos

<p>Comment: BMP's were installed since the previous inspection but do not appear to have been installed in accordance with good engineering practices. Rock rip/rap has been placed along the road where erosion channel was documented in the previous inspection. There are rock rip/rap check dams with sandbags however they don't appear to be constructed correctly as stormwater will flow around the check dams to the low areas causing erosion. There are straw wattles placed near the culvert of the road and at areas of the location. It appears stormwater is beginning to flow underneath some of the wattles at the location causing erosion. Straw blanket was placed in areas at the location. The degraded silt fence was removed. See Attached Photos</p>

It is understood that the newly constructed road is being built for development of the property. A surveyor was near the location during inspection and conversation with the surveyor indicates that 35 acre parcels are being divided up on the property and will intersect the existing access road.
