Y34-16 Multi Siting Rationale

Y34-16 Multi has been positioned to meet COGCC setbacks from Building Unit Owners.

- Mineral Development - This Pad allows Noble to reach minerals located within the Town of Keenesburg which is densely developed and urbanized. This project will develop minerals in Sections 34, 27, 22, T2N, R64W with industry leading technology 2.5 mile long laterals. This plan minimizes surface impacts by maximizing well-bore step-outs; while utilizing industry leading well-bore lengths.
- Surface Location – Noble has an executed Surface Use Agreement from the Land Owner; in which the Land Owner prefers these locations to minimize impacts to farming operations. The locations of these pads are situated in such a way to allow for future urban expansion and development.
- Water/Gas/Oil – The production facility location was chosen due to its close proximity to existing infrastructure therefor Noble was able to utilize a near tank-less facility and reduce truck traffic. Due to the engineered modular design, these facilities must be linear in origin to have optimal connection to pipeline gathering systems. Near tank-less facilities do not have the flexibility of equipment placement that prior tanked facilities did. Noble has designed these facilities (modular designed near tank-less) to minimize surface impacts while maximizing production efficiencies. Any areas within the disturbance will be utilized for production personnel to have enough space to operate the facility safely. (i.e. equipment maintenance, truck turn-around, muster areas...)
