Dear Director Lepore,

Crestone Peak Resources is making application for a drilling permit for the above captioned well. As currently planned, the wellbore(s) listed below will lie within 150 feet of the horizontal lateral of the captioned well.

Prior to drilling operations, Crestone will perform an anti-collision review of existing offset wells that have the potential of being within close proximity of the proposed well. This anti-collision review may include MWD or gyro surveys and surface locations of the offset wells with included error of uncertainty per survey instrument, and compared against the proposed wellpath with its respective error of uncertainty. If current surveys do not exist for the offset wells, Crestone may have gyro surveys conducted to verify bottom hole location. The proposed well will only be drilled if the anti-collision scan results indicate that there is not a risk for collision, harm to people or the environment. For the proposed well, upon conclusion of drilling operations, an "as-built" gyro survey will be submitted to COGCC with the Form 5.

Rule 317.s. of the Colorado Oil and Gas Commission's Rules and Regulations states that "No portion of a proposed wellbore's treated interval shall be located within 150 feet of an existing (producing, shut-in, or temporarily abandoned) or permitted oil and gas wellbore's treated interval belonging to another operator without the signed written consent of the operator of the encroached upon wellbore."

For well(s) listed above, the encroached-upon offset operator is Crestone Peak, therefore no written consent written consent is required.

Crestone respectfully requests the Director allow the captioned well to be drilled within 150 feet of the well(s) listed.
