The Jurisdictional Agency determination was based on information contained in or added to the Application. Review by the professional staff of the Colorado Commission indicates that this well is an (~~New~~) (Old) well. The well produces from the "J" Sand reservoir(s); This well qualified as a stripper well under Filing No. 79-846. The well produced non associated natural gas at a rate exceeding 60 MCF per day during the "90 day" periods as follows:
