Comment: Crop vegetation over the well location has achieved uniform distribution and is indistinguishable from the adjacent reference areas. However, crop vegetation over the access road is significantly stunted when compared to the adjacent reference area. This is likely due to compaction concerns (see comments). Perform reclamation on access road in accordance to COGCC 1000 series reclamation requirements and standards. To allow time for Noble to collaborate with the surface owner and determine mitigating measures that will allow reclamation work to be conducted in such a manner as to not interfere with agricultural activities or crop production, and to allow time for Noble to identify the issues hindering crop growth, all additional reclamation activities shall be completed no later than September 15th, 2017
