Comment: There is a perimeter fence around the location which appears to be maintained. The desirable vegetation cover at the location has not adequately established and there is predominantly undesirable weeds such as Kochia and Horseweed. The undesirable weeds are over 3.5 feet tall in areas and appear to be impeding desirable vegetation establishment and will become a debris source once it dies off this fall. Additional reseeding and weed control is needed to facilitate the establishment of desirable vegetation. See Attached Photos

Establish vegetation with total perennial, non-invasive uniform plant cover of at least eighty (80) percent of pre-disturbance or reference area levels. Use a seed mixture requested by the surface owner, or a mixture prescribed by the local county NRCS. Ensure erosion controls are implemented to stabilize the seeded soil, and continue to monitor and manage this site until Final Reclamation has passed.	CostaR	08/16/2017
The fence around the location will need to be removed once vegetation has adequately re-established in order to pass a final reclamation inspection. The fence will need to be maintained until it is removed.	CostaR	08/16/2017
