Extraction Oil & Gas, Inc. (Extraction) hereby certifies that it has complied with Rule 306.e, which states that an Operator shall be available to meet with Building Unit Owners who received an OGLA notice or a buffer zone notice pursuant to Rule 305.c. and requested a meeting regarding the proposed oil and gas location. The operator sent notices pursuant to Rule 305.c, and received a request from one Building Unit Owner (Ryan and Jenna Schaefer). Extraction's landman spoke with the Building Unit Owner (BUO) on August 18, 2017.

The BUO wanted to know if there were going to be sound walls for the operations and it was explained that per the BMPs this location will utilize sound walls.

Additionally the BUO asked if Extraction plans to pipe or truck the oil. Extraction strives to bring oil pipe to all locations and this was shared with the BUO. It was explained that Extraction is currently in the process of obtaining the necessary agreements and infrastructure to bring oil pipe to this location.

Lastly, the BUO wanted to know what the final footprint will look like and if Extraction was open to suggestions. Extraction explained that final reclamation decisions are between the operator and the surface owner but that we are open to suggestions. Extraction will attempt to include the BUO in reclamation conversations if the surface owner is open to it.
