The disturbance location is not reflective of reference area vegetation that is comprised of Russian wildrye (*Elymus junceus*).

Location (~35'x35') does not meet Rule 1004 standards as the disturbance of the location is evident and mainly consist of weedy, annual vegetation. The disturbance location is not reflective of reference area vegetation that is comprised of Russian wildrye (*Elymus junceus*). Subsidence was observed at the northern well location.
