Environmental	<p>Based on the information presented, it appears that no further action is necessary at this time and the COGCC approves the closure request. However, should future conditions at the site indicate contaminant concentrations in soils exceeding COGCC standards or if ground water is found to be impacted, then further investigation and/or remediation activities may be required. In addition, the surface area disturbed by the remediation activity shall be reclaimed in accordance with the 1000 Series Reclamation Rules.</p> <p>Materials with pH, SAR, or EC concentrations exceeding Table 910-1 levels may be buried under a minimum of three (3) feet of backfill cover and soil that satisfies either the Table 910-1 levels for pH, SAR, and EC or the background levels for such contaminants within three (3) feet of the ground surface at the site. In addition, soil horizons must be replaced in their original relative position and reclaimed in accordance with 1000 Series Rules, including the establishment of vegetative cover on non-cropland and successful crop growth on cropland.</p>	08/30/2017
