Once again, I apologize for not responding to inspections that were conducted at these sites in 2016. We did not receive those inspections due to an error in the email address they were sent to. They were sent to Sherri

Robbins, rather than to Noble's inspection email address, and the address entered contained an extra 'e'. I have attached a screen shot of that, as you requested. Good Morning Margaret,

I called and left a message on your office phone. To briefly summarize, these (Petro-Canada) locations were on an "Operator with 10 locations or less requiring bond release inspection" spreadsheet provided by financial assurance. Ms. Sherri Robbins was listed as the contact for Petro-Canada in this document, which is why Noble's inspection email had not been used. Towards the end of 2016 after a follow-up inspection, I had discovered that Ms. Robbins email contact for Petro-Canada provided had a spelling error. I immediately contacted financial assurance to confirm this so they could update the information in their master list.

At the same time I also notified Denise (and I believe we had discussions with you) and informed her as to what had happened. We then contacted Noble towards the end of 2016 and had conversations regarding the concerns identified in my inspections, and the mistake that had been made regarding the email contact. Per Denise, Noble was provided an extension of 5/31/2017 for each inspected location to perform the work needed to bring the locations back into compliance. Please note that the reclamation group had both verbal and written communication with Noble regarding this. Please see the attached email correspondence that was submitted to both Scott Park and Sherri Robbins on 1/3/2017. This correspondence was also uploaded in to each respective location's file.

I hope this has provided some clarification. Per Noble's conversations with you, I will plan on performing follow-up inspections on these locations after the agreed date above of August 31st, 2017.

Abby,

I do want to let you know that the error in the email address was recognized in January 2017. Please see attached copy of email correspondence where both Sherri and Scot were notified of the problem. Due to this contact information issue the corrective action date was extended to May 31, 2017. The extension to respond by August 31, 2017 that we discussed last week, is still valid. However, the 8-31-2017 response must include active reclamation, stormwater controls, and remediation were necessary. Seeding should be conducted within the 2017 fall seeding window.

A similar corrective action correspondence document was completed for each location you identified in your August 4, 2017 email. The COGCC will not be able to grant further delays or extensions.
