Google Earth imagery taken on June 14, 2016 illustrating the location that was mapped on September 7, 2017 using a Trimble Juno 3B handheld device. GPS data would indicate construction disturbance was exceeded by approximately 2.41 acres (55% overbuilt), totaling 6.76 acres.

Photo 4. Photo taken from the eastern location, facing North. Appears topsoil has been salvaged and stored along the eastern and northern well pad perimeters. Topsoil has been mulched with a filtrex wattle installed around the toe of slope.

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Photo 5. Photo taken from the northern location, facing West. Ditch BMP has been installed around well pad perimeter and portions of the outer perimeter.



Photo 6. Photo taken from the northwest location, facing West. Ditch BMP that installed around the northern topsoil stockpile ends at a stabilized area made of rip-rap. Filtrexx BMPs have been installed along the northwestern, western, and southern location perimeters.

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Photo 7. Photo taken from the northwest location, facing South. Ditch BMP installed around the well pad perimeter is directed to the western sediment trap- see photo 9.



Photo 8. Photo taken from the southwest location, facing East. Ditch BMP has been installed around well pad perimeter and portions of the outer perimeter, in addition to filterxx BMP outside of the ditch BMP. A small portion along the southern perimeter outside of the fenced area was not mapped but appeared to be oil and gas disturbances. Ditch and filterxx BMP observed outside the fenced area.

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Photo 9. Photo taken from the western sediment trap, facing North. Sediment trap has been installed with a stabilized outlet, in addition to filtrex BMP along the outer perimeter.
