4. Comments provided to the COGCC, LGD or Operator: 03/15/2017
  - City of Thornton Comment:
    - An email was sent on 05/12/2017 to Grant Penland (City of Thornton) with an invitation to offer consultation on the Adams County AUSR application.
    - Adams County responded to City of Thornton's comments on AUSR application on 08/15/2017.
  - Adams County LGD Comment:
    - A detailed Adams county AURS application was filed on 07/13/2017 and is currently in review with the county.
5. Meetings requested and documentation:
  - On 08/17/2016 Great Western staff met with Mr. George Lombardi (Homeowner) located to the west of the proposed location to discuss proposed operations and light/sound mitigation.
  - On 04/03/2017 Great Western staff responded to an email request from Mr. George Lombardi (Homeowner) located to the west of the proposed location to clarify construction plans, and landscaping. Email response from Drilling Engineer suggested setting up time to discuss drilling plans via phone call or in person, no follow up meeting was made.
  - On 05/04/2017 Great Western held a Neighborhood meeting at the Todd Creek Golf Club, 8455 Heritage Drive, Thornton, CO 80602 as part of the Adams Co. AUSR process. This meeting discussed the plans for this proposed Oil and Gas Location and had many Great Western staff members representing Drilling & Completions, Regulatory and EH&S, Geology, and Land. As a result of public feedback Great western modified this proposed location to include an earthen berm on the west side of this location to reduce visual and noise impacts for the homeowners to the west of the location.
