Hi Michael,

I sent the Cottonwood Fed 07M-1902 and 1934 off for final approval last week, but some questions came up that need clarification on the right to construct.

Since the pad is in Sec 7, and the two wells go south through Sec 18-19, the described lease cannot be the right to construct, since the lease (as described) does not underlie the surface location.

The existing permitted wells trending south from the pad have a different lease description that includes 1104 acres (more than the 829 in these APDs), some of which is in Sec 7 where the SHL is. This "extra" 273 acres is what you've cited as the lease description for the northbound wells.

Can you please clarify what the lease actually is? If the single lease does include all 1104 acres, then we should have stated that on the northbound Cottonwood APDs, and we can include the whole 1104 acres for the two southbound Cottonwood APDs.

If these are actually separate leases, then we will need an SUA for the right to construct on the southbound wells, and Sundries to correct that on the already-permitted wells.
