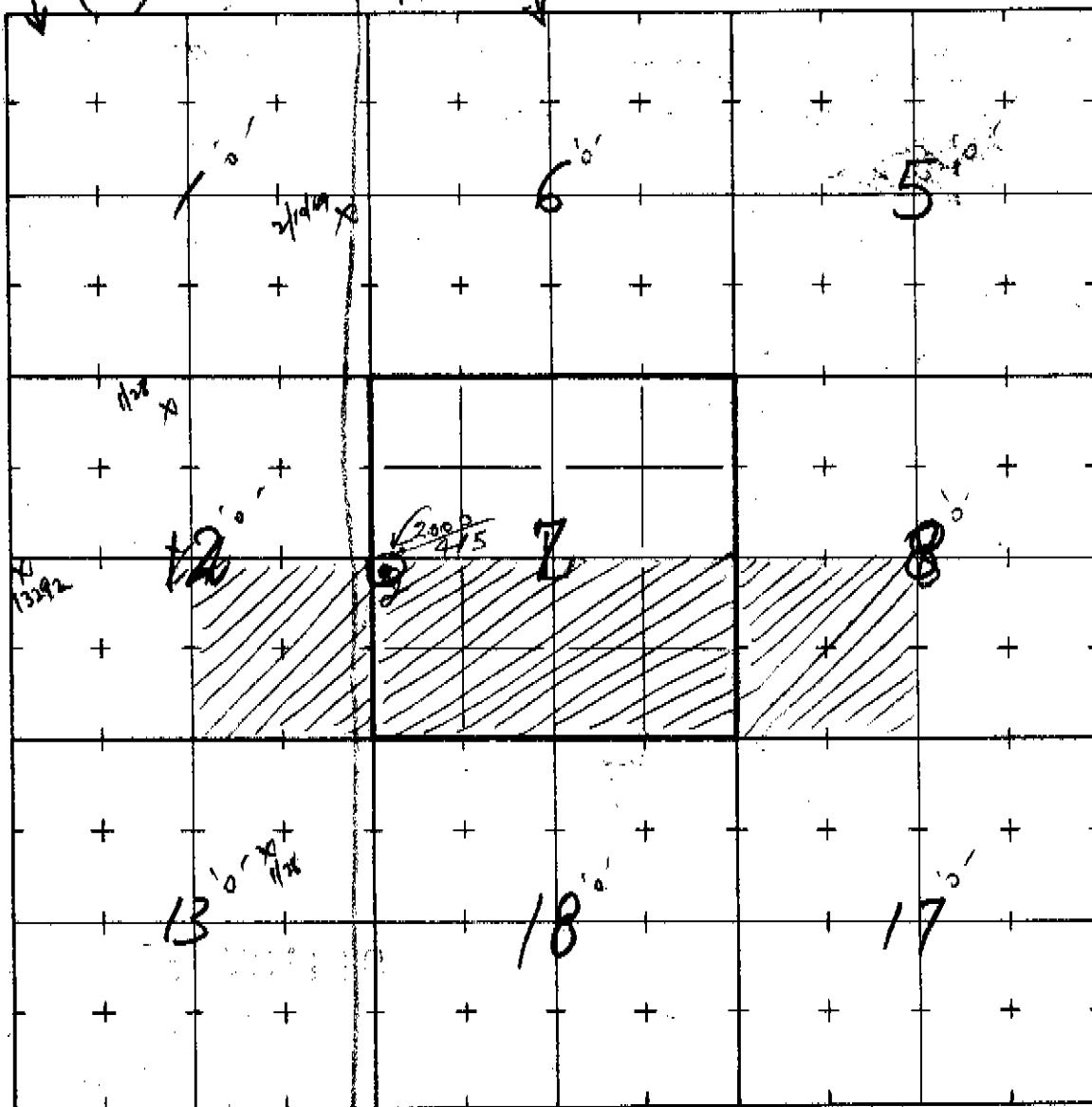

Dear Mr. Cogburn:

By receipt of this letter you are advised that your conditional permit No. 14132-F issued June 24, 1969, for construction of a well in the Northwest 1/4 of the Southwest 1/4 of Section 7, Township 33 South, Range 41 West of the 6th Principal Meridian, Baca County, Colorado, is due to expire.

Pursuant to Section 148-18-7 Colorado Revised Statutes, as amended, the permit shall expire and be of no force or effect at the expiration of one year from the date that it was issued unless the well has been constructed and the water has been put to beneficial use within that time. The expiration date for the above permit then is June 24, 1970. Unless the well is constructed by that time, or a request for an extension of time received in this office by that time, the permit is null and void and any well drilled under it would be subject to legal action pursuant to Section 148-18-9 CRS 1963, as amended.

If the well has been drilled by that date, the water has not been put to beneficial use, the Ground Water Commission will grant a one year extension to put the water to beneficial use if you will simply write to this office and request it. Additional extensions after that year may be granted by the Commission if good cause can be shown why they are needed.

As mentioned above, an extension of time to drill the well must be received by this office prior to the expiration date. The Ground Water Commission will generally grant a 30 or 60 day extension, but only upon your showing of a good cause as to why this extension is needed.

If the well is drilled prior to the expiration, the completion report (MAP AND STATEMENT FOR WATER WELL FILING) must be submitted to this office within seven days after the expiration date, or the permit will be of no force or effect, and any well drilled under it will again be subject to legal action pursuant to 148-18-9 CRS 1963, as amended.

If you do not fully understand any part of this letter, or if you have any questions on this matter, please contact us, as your well permit is a very valuable right.
