Comment: COGCC Environmental Staff responded spill reported by DCP near Weld county Road 62 & 47. According to an onsite contractor an excavation crew constructing a new driveway related to the county road widening of WCR 47 struck a 3" DCP pipeline causing a gas and condensate release. The condensate misted a residence and the gravel and road base in the rear of the house. The residents were temporarily evacuated during the incident. Impacted material around the residence had been removed and further excavation around the pipeline was pending utility locates.

Corrective Action: Form 19 Supplemental Report is due 12/8/2017. DCP is to report cleanup of residence and affected soil using future Form 19 Supplemental Reports. Date: 12/08/2017
