Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your letter of January 7, 1960 concerning compliance of requirements of the Commission on the plugging of wells Williamson No. 1, Gillette No. 8 and Steinke No. 1, Keota Field.

On January 4 we received a letter from The National Supply Company giving details of the plugging of the Steinke No. 1. This letter has been accepted as the plugging record for this well. However, we have not, to date, received any plugging records for the Williamson No. 1 and Gillette No. 8.

In addition, it has been noted that the new operator of Keota Field has submitted production reports commencing with October 1959. We are still lacking a report for September. Inasmuch as the effective date of change of operators for the field is September 30, your Company is still responsible for submitting the September report.

We would appreciate receiving as soon as possible the plugging reports for the two wells mentioned above and also the production report for the month of September 1959. Upon receipt of these reports, the files concerning your Company's operations in the Keota field should be complete.
