CAUSE INFORMATION: The line separated at the valve and drained oil and produced water to secondary containment. It turned out that the liner of the secondary containment had some leaks, and some of the oil and produced water leaked to the dirt below. This is an area of shallow water table, so they reported this release. The release was reported to COGCC at the time it was discovered. They are coordinating things so that they should be able to begin pulling the tanks on Monday, May 12th. They have to remove the tank before they can excavate the impacted dirt. At this time there is no knowledge of impact to water.
