THE EVAPORATION PIT WAS CLOSED. ALL PETROLEUM-CONTAMINATED SOILS ENCOUNTERED WERE SENT TO THE BFI TOWER LANDFILL FOR DISPOSAL. SALT CONTAMINATED SOILS WERE SENT TO THE LINCOLN CO LANDFILL. EXCAVATION WAS CONDUCTED TO THE WATER TABLE ABOUT 9 FT DOWN. THE PIT AREA WAS BACKFILLED WITH CLEAN FILL. PETROLEUM CONTAMINATED SOILS NEAR THE TANK BATTERY WILL ALSO BE EXCAVATED AND SENT TO TOWER. ALL SURFACE FACILITIES AND TRASH WILL BE REMOVED FROM THIS SITE.

IMPACTED SOIL BENEATH THE EVAPORATION PIT AND TANK BATTERY AREA WAS EXCAVATED AND DISPOSED OF OFF SITE AT COMMERCIAL LANDFILLS. THE EXCAVATED AREAS WERE BACKFILLED WITH CLEAN FILL AND COMPACTED. ALL SURFACE FACILITIES AND TRASH WERE REMOVED FROM THE SITE. THE DISTURBED AREA WASE GRADED AND RESEEDED USING AN APPROPRIATE SEED MIX PRIOR TO WINTER.
