Steve,

Per our conversation on the phone, Noble will elect to perform Option 4 as an offset to Verdad's Jackson pad in sec 28/33 2N64W. As part of the Option 4, we will monitor casing and surface casing pressures during the stimulation job

and communicate any variances to the baseline pressure to Verdad. Our goal is to not see ANY pressure on the surface casing gauge during frac as there should be adequate cement coverage over the Niobrara.

We will have Verdad submit the sundry to the COA for their horizontal wells. If there are any questions regarding this, please reach out to myself or Brandi Wilson.
