Good afternoon Kelsi and Rebecca,

Per our conversation today, COGCC's maps for this site being within the bald eagle winter night roost (orange polygon) are accurate and the NE corner of this proposed development is within this buffer. CPW's recommendations for bald eagle winter night roosts are below (and was taken from [this document](#)), and it sounds like Extraction will complete their work prior to November 15 (likely mid-late October). Therefore, CPW has no further concerns regarding work within that roost buffer.

Also, this site is located outside an active bald eagle nest buffer (blue polygon), and CPW has no further concerns regarding this proposed development outside this adjacent active nest buffer.

Winter Night Roost: No human encroachment from November 15 through March 15 within a ¼ mile radius of an active winter night roost if there is no direct line of sight between the roost and the encroachment activities. No human encroachment from November 15 through March 15 within a ½ mile radius of an active winter night roost if there is a direct line of sight between the roost and the encroachment activities. If periodic visits (such as oil well maintenance work) are required within the buffer zone after development, activity should be restricted to the period between 1000 and 1400 hours from November 15 to March 15.

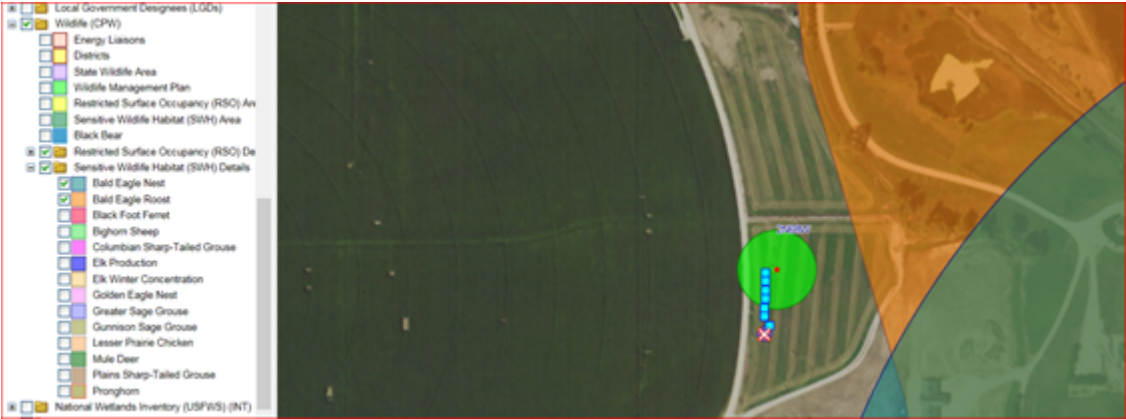
Kelsi,
